Each whole-picture stands for 10 years. Each half-picture stands for 5 years.

- ▶ How old was Benjamin Harrison when he became President?

Put your finger on Benjamin Harrison's name. Move right and count the pictures.

- ▶ There are five whole pictures and one half-picture. Multiply 5 and 10. Then add 5 for the half-picture.

Benjamin Harrison was **55 years old** when he became President.
